Speakers Biography

Dr Rosario Cerundolo, DVM, Cert. VD, Dipl. ECVD, MRCVS

Rosario Cerundolo graduated from the Veterinary School, Naples (Italy) in 1987. In 1998 he got the European Diploma in Veterinary Dermatology and in 2000 the RCVS Specialist in Veterinary Dermatology. Until 2009 he was Associate Professor in Veterinary Dermatology at the University of Pennsylvania. Currently works at Dick White Referrals and he is a Honorary Associate Professor of Veterinary Dermatology at the University of Nottingham.

RCVS and European Specialist in Veterinary Ophthalmology**

Heidi graduated from London University's Royal Veterinary College in 1991. She gained her RCVS Diploma in Veterinary Ophthalmology in 2001, and her European Diploma in Veterinary Ophthalmology in 2005. Heidi joined the ophthalmology team at Willows Referral Service in 2006. She is a member of the BVA/KC/ISDS Eye Panel, the Executive Secretary of the ECVO (European College of Veterinary Ophthalmologists) and a visiting lecturer at the University of Nottingham. She has published on several aspects of veterinary ophthalmology and is a regular speaker at conferences both in the UK and overseas. Her clinical interests include corneal disease and the surgical management of cataract.

I have grown up with breeding and showing dogs and a keen interest in animals with both my parents being vets. My main breed is Gordon Setters but I also grew up with Airedale and Smooth Fox Terriers.
